We encourage stakeholders to review the series of maps that accompany the Draft Final Stream Corridor Management Plan (the plan, including these maps, is available for review at <http://arcadecreek.org/management-documents.html>). The maps, which were presented at the August 2007 watershed group meeting, show the results of the 2007 field surveys that identified restoration opportunities along the Arcade Creek stream corridor. Although a full survey was conducted of the Arcade and Cripple Creeks stream corridor during the 2007 surveys, stakeholder input is important to make sure that all opportunities have been identified.

#### **Project Background**

The Arcade Creek Watershed Group is composed of local residents; environmental, recreational, and other community groups; and representatives from the Cities of Sacramento and Citrus Heights and the County of Sacramento. The mission of the Arcade Creek Watershed Group is to improve water quality, reduce flood damage, enhance habitat, increase recreational opportunities, and encourage local participation in watershed protection efforts.

To accomplish their mission, the Arcade Creek Watershed Group is working on development of a comprehensive Stream Corridor Management Plan that includes proactive planning, improvement projects, increased community education, and ongoing stewardship of Arcade Creek. The CALFED Bay-Delta Watershed Program, in conjunction with the California State Resources Control Board, is providing funding for this effort.
